Innovative Teaching Practices

OSCE conducted by Department of Medicine

Department of Medicine has conducted Practical PCT of Batch B of 2017 ABCD batch by OSCE method on 27/10/21. Ten Stations were prepared in such a manner that all 3 i.e cognitive, psychomotor and communications skills could be examined. First 3 station were patient stations related to history taking, general examination and systemic per abdominal examination. Checklists were prepared and residents were appointed as observers. 4th - 6th stations were photo stations were photographs of typical and common physical findings were kept and students were expected to identify abnormality and answer questions related to those physical findings. 7th and 8th stations were investigation stations where an ECG and X-ray were kept for identification and answer related questions. 9th station was station on communication skills. Students were given the task of explaining about importance of medical nutrition therapy and exercise to diabetic patient. Tenth station was Teacher Evaluation Station, in which senior faculties from department took viva based on patient stations. In this exam we also took help of standardized patients. On history station a nursing student and an intern were given the job of patient. Overall all the three domains were evaluated during this exam. Dr. Tanuja Manohar was the coordinator of OSCE examination.



Peer Assisted Learning by Medicine Department

Department of Medicine has started a novel series of teaching- Learning session titled 'Peer assisted learning. First session was conducted in collaboration with Dept of Ophthalmology on 28th and 29th October. Fundus examination is an important part of Nervous system examination which is often neglected. In this session Third year residents of Ophthalmology taught Fundus examination to Third year and second year Medicine residents. Session was restricted to diabetic and hypertensive retinopathy. After theoretical discussion for 15 minutes, hands on training was given to each and every resident. Medicine residents attended session in two batches. 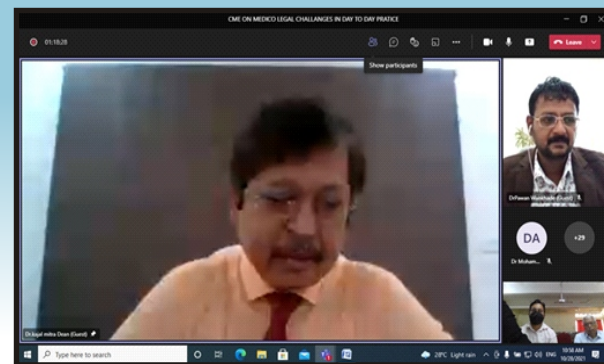
The enthusiastic participation of 27 Postgraduates and interns was responsible for the big Success of the event.

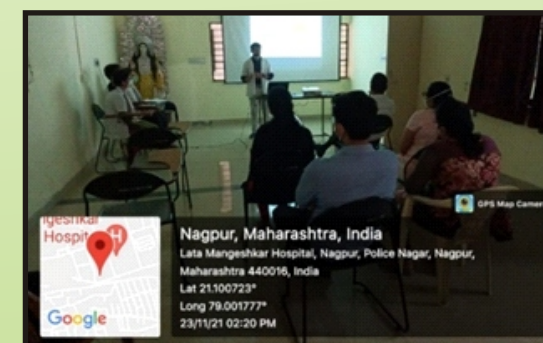

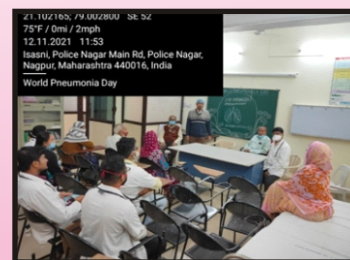
National Nutrition Week 2021 Celebration "Healthy Baby Contest"
