Team Based Learning: Educational Model Making by dept of General Medicine

Department of Medicine had recently adopted a novel concept of Team Based Learning to make Educational Model Making competition on 24th January 2022 Every unit was designated as one team. Each team was comprised of Faculty members as well as JRs posted in the unit. A clinically relevant topic was chosen.

First week was spent by each team in brain storming and finalizing topic for model. Next week was spent in deciding how to prepare model and what material to use etc. Thereafter teachers did the role of facilitators and motivators.



As soon as Educational model was finalised, it was shared in the department group in order to avoid repetition. 6 educational models titled Haemodialysis Unit, Alcoholic Liver Disease, Internal Capsule -applied anatomy, Conduction system of heart and CHB, Blood transfusion -advantages and disadvantages and Electro-encephalography.

Our model prepared by Unit 1, Haemodialysis machine bagged 1st prize in Interdepartmental competition. All the models are kept in departmental seminar hall and will be regularly used for UG teaching.
