Accreditation in Medical Institutions

There are thousands of medical institutions providing education and training to aspiring physicians around the world. The medical education curriculums, training offered, available resources, length of study, etc., vary widely depending on regional, political and other factors. This variability in medical educational, combined with the rapid increases in the number of medical colleges worldwide and increasing international mobility for education and employment necessitates quality assurance, such as formal accreditation systems, to ensure medical educational institutions function appropriately

Accreditation is a process by which a statutory body determines if an educational institution and/or programme meet defined standards of quality. Being accredited means that a facility or health care organization has met certain quality standards. These standards are set by private, nationally recognized groups that check on the quality of care at health care facilities and organizations. Once achieved, accreditation is not permanent, it is renewed periodically to ensure that the quality of the educational program is maintained.

Accreditation systems in medical education aim to assure various stakeholders, including students, educators in graduate and postgraduate educational programs, employers, and patients, that graduates are ready to begin practice. Oversight of the educational content and pedagogical methods is necessary to ensure that the learning needs of the students are met and endeavour to ultimately impact the quality of medical care provided to patients. An important aim of the accreditation process should be encouraging ongoing institutional improvement and fostering the dissemination of best practices, both regionally and globally.
