- The inclusion of these skills in the curriculum of all undergraduate medical schools;
- Inclusion in the assessment of an entry to specialty training;
- Be part of annual appraisal of doctors in training;
 Be used as a part of exit assessment for postgraduate doctors
- •Including these skills in the senior doctor's appraisal and revalidation process;
- •Teaching these skills through courses and workshops as part of continuous medical education.

The Competency Based Medical Education curriculum has incorporated these skills in curriculum of undergraduates and Postgraduates. The biggest challenge is to implement it properly and for that teachers' training and commitment is necessary.


