**Workshop on “Septorhinoplasty : A Step by Step Approach”**

A Live Surgical Workshop on “Septorhinoplasty : A Step-by-Step Approach” was organised by Department of Otorhinolaryngology, NKPSIMS & RC and LMH, Nagpur in collaboration with AOI & HNS Vidarbha on 22<sup>nd</sup> of March 2025.
