Report: Resident as Teacher – Basic Workshop in Educational Methodology

The Medical Education Technology Unit in association with VSPM's College of Physiotherapy, Nagpur conducted a two-day Resident as Teacher – Basic Workshop in Educational Methodology for physiotherapy residents on 19th and 20th August 2025 at Inspire Hall, NKPSIMS & RC and LMH. The workshop aimed to enhance the teaching skills of residents, enabling them to contribute effectively to undergraduate medical education. Thirty residents from various departments actively participated.

Day 1 commenced with registration, an introduction, and a pre-test, followed by sessions on the process of learning, learning domains, and formulating educational objectives. Participants engaged in microteaching practice, discussions on communication skills, small group learning, and the one-minute preceptor method. The day concluded with a session on effective use of teaching aids and group feedback.

Day 2 covered effective lecturing, providing constructive feedback, and the principles and tools of assessment, including written assessments. Hands-on training in Objective Structured Clinical Examination (OSCE) was provided, followed by a post-test and feedback session. The program ended with an extended microteaching exercise and the valedictory session.

The workshop was highly interactive, with residents appreciating the opportunity to develop practical teaching competencies. Participants expressed enthusiasm for applying these skills in their clinical teaching roles.
