Subject: Students' Feedback Report.

An online students' Feedback Form was used to get the students feedback about infrastructure, curriculum and teaching. This was analysed by IQAC team maintaining confidentiality.

The average response on all points ranged from fair to very good. The best responses were for the following:

1. Curricula and syllabi are covered in the Discipline (97.9%).
2. All teachers are involved in theory & practical classes in the discipline (97.8%).
3. Most of the teachers are effectively communicating domain knowledge using IT skills and soft skills (86.8%).
4. Mentoring process is beneficial for cognitive, social and emotional growth of the student (94.5%).
5. Opportunities for experiential learning are being provided to the students to enhance their knowledge (95.6%).
6. Value-added courses/training in professional ethics and values, community service, preventive health care and rural health care are adequate (96.8%).
7. The teachers are fair enough for the internal evaluation process (92.3%).
8. The results of examinations are declared in time (93.4%).
9. Teachers enable students to identify their strength and weakness and overcome the weakness by providing timely counselling and care (90.1%).

Few students suggested that they need more live demonstrations, cadaveric workshops, more assessment, more practical approach and digital learning.

These suggestions will be conveyed to all Head of Departments.












































