Report of Resident as a Teacher

A Beyond the Blackboard – A Teaching Technology Workshop for Senior Residents was conducted for faculty members with the objective of enhancing understanding of Competency-Based Medical Education (CBME), teaching–learning methods, assessment strategies, and related educational practices on 17th and 18th Feb 2026.

The workshop was attended by a total of 24 participants representing various departments of the institution. The participants included faculty members from both clinical and non-clinical disciplines, ensuring multidisciplinary interaction and sharing of experiences.
