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REPORT OF ALSO WORKSHOP

The Department of OBGY, NKPSIMS & LMH, Nagpur organized American Academy of Family Physicians-recognised Advanced Life Support in Obstetrics Workshop for postgraduate students (Junior Residents 2nd year) of Obstetrics & Gynaecology.

It was a day long workshop which started at 8.00 am with registration. Dr. Savita Somalwar delivered an introductory lecture regarding the course Agenda & Purpose of conducting the workshop. Dr. Rohini Bhoyar delivered lecture on 'Safety in Pregnancy' course, which emphasized on Team work, Shared Mental Model, Closed loop communication, Simulation & Standardised protocol in dealing with Emergency obstetrics situations.

Dr. Sheela Jain delivered a lecture on Maternal Resuscitation which was followed by a hands-on workstation on Maternal Resuscitation; students were given a clinical scenario of cord Prolapse and managed the situation based on mnemonics & protocol on Mannequins.

Dr. Savita Somalwar & Dr. Prajakta Junewar discussed cases on Labour Dystocia & Eclampsia respectively.

Group testing of participants was taken on Emergency obstetrics situations, like eclampsia, third-trimester bleeding, Cord Prolapse, Breech Forceps-Vacuum & Shoulder Dystocia.

Feedback from participants was taken. Certificates were distributed to the participants. The total number of participants were 13 including 3 participants from the faculty.
